The ministry is pressing on by the grace of God through Jesus Christ. Apart from preaching the gospel in villages and places where are oppressed by the power of Satan, God has put a burden to us to reach out youths and help them to know Christ and to walk in the right ways that pleasing God.

TEACH a child the right way to follow according to the scripture, and when he grows, he will not depart from it. What then can we say of this generation of youths, that they did not listen to their parents or that their parents did not fulfill their obligations according to the scripture? Sexual immoralities have become the order of the day. Girls no longer cherish chaste and dignity of womanhood is long gone. Men have lost control over their emotions. It is obvious that the youths today do not see pre-marital sex as an immoral act.



Two weeks ago we had conducted a youth training to teach them about how to abstain from immorality.

The turn-up was very positive we had about **3,000 youths** came to attend the training and it was very successful.

My wife and I had an opportunity to speak with these thousands of youths who are hungry and thirsty to hear the word of God.

Sexual immorality is a temptation that is always before youths mostly. In movies and television, sex outside marriage is treated as a normal, even desirable, part of life. While marriage is often portrayed as confining and joyless. But God does not forbid sexual immorality just to make life more difficult. He knows its power to destroy people especially the youth physically and spiritually. It has devastated countless lives and destroyed families. God wants to protect youths from damaging themselves and others.





Sexual immorality among the youths that is, the urge to have sex is more on the youths as compared to other ages. Most at times, the urge for sex becomes uncontrollable predominantly among the males. When there is self-indiscipline, this can lead to rape and we have seen this happen a lot among our youths. That is why we felt it is importance to bring the youth together for a training to help them to be aware and to know how to discipline themselves from immorality activities.

We taught the youths that, God requires them to use self-control in sexual matters. If they are not married that means abstaining from sexual relations. When they get married, this means staying faithful to their partner for life. We have challenged the youth to open their eyes and see that immorality can lead to early marriage and poverty. When a young boy or girl is forced into marriage as a result of pre-marital sex when there is no source of lively hood, the end is always miserable. It leads to frustration and loss of dreams.



What then do we do to save this generation in Africa and elsewhere? All hope is not lost but there is a lot of work to be done if sexual promiscuity among the youth could be curbed, in the first place, parents should give their children adequate sex education. Should they fail in their duty, young people will be misinformed by their peers who believe that virginity is no longer the dignity of a young woman.

Girls should avoid keeping private company with boy(s) to keep temptation at bay. They should strive for chaste and keep their virginity. This is the dignity of womanhood.

Finally, we had challenged young people to give their lives to JESUS CHRIST. They should endeavor to attend their religious programmes and hear the word of God regularly. We thank God that we had over hundred who came forward to receive Jesus Christ as their personal savior.
